AGE DIVISIONS & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

8 and under (born 2011+)
9 - 10 (born 2009 - 2010)
11 - 12 (born 2007 - 2008)
13 - 14 (born 2005 - 2006)
15 - 16 (born 2003 - 2004)
17 - 18 (born 2001 - 2002)
<i>* athletes born in 2000 are also eligible if they do not turn 19 on or before 7/28/2019</i>



Individuals: Only U.S. citizens, aliens living in the United States and foreign exchange students are eligible to compete in these Championships. See the USATF Rules for more information and exceptions. A competitor must compete in his/her age division only. There will be no "moving up" in any events, including relays. Competitors in the 8 & Under 9-10 and 11-12 age divisions may compete in a maximum of three (3) events, including relays. Competitors in the 13-14, 15-16 and 17-18 age divisions may compete in a maximum of four (4) events, including relays. Combined events are not included in the event count. All athletes must be 2019 members of USATF in good standing.

Rule 300 I (c): ***Athletes must be at least seven (7) years of age on December 31 of the current year to compete in the Youth Athletics or Junior Olympics National Championship.*** Any athlete who does not meet this requirement will not be able to advance to the Junior Olympics National Championship.

Relay Teams: Only registered 2019 USATF member clubs may enter a relay team(s). All athletes representing the club must be affiliated with and members of that club as part of their USATF membership. Visit www.usatf.org/membership.

- Individual Entries: **\$9** per event
- Relay Entries: **\$36** per relay team
- Triathlon/Pentathlon: **\$17** per event
- Decathlon/Heptathlon: **\$22** per event

REGISTRATION AND MOVE UP PROCESS:

ONLINE REGISTRATION: The top 8 finishers in each event from the Hawaii, Nevada, San Diego Imperial and Southern California Association Championships are eligible to compete at the Regional 15 Championship. At the conclusion of the Association Championship Meets, Club Administrators and Unattached Athletes must register online by **11:59 PM PST June 15, 2019** at the following link: <https://www.athletic.net/TrackAndField/School.aspx?SchoolID=67721>. **Late entries will not be allowed.** Online registration opens **June 11, 2019 at 5:00 PM PST**. **Fees must be paid online by the close of registration. Only VISA and electronic check will be accepted.** A completed registration includes the payment of all entry fees. If you miss the window to register, you have missed the opportunity to compete. The next

athlete(s) on the results will have the opportunity to be moved up and become eligible for participation at this competition. Following the initial registration period, the online registration will re-open to allow athletes to move into an event where fewer than 8 finishers declared entry during the initial registration period (see above). **The “Move-Up” period will be open for 48 hours beginning at 8:00AM on June 17, 2019 and close on June 19, 2019 at 8:00AM.** Teams and athletes are encouraged to check www.athletic.net for accurate date and times. Late entries will not be allowed. Fees must be paid online by the close of registration. Accuracy of data entered is the responsibility of each club and/or athlete. Please validate data within Athletic.net for accuracy prior to submitting entry. An instructional video on the online registration process can be found here: <http://cs.athletic.net/blog/b/athletic/archive/2016/01/18/getting-started-athletic-net-tutorials.aspx>. **Valid 2019 USATF Membership and Proof of Birth is required for participation.** Prior to your Association Championship meet, please ensure that your membership chair has received proof of birth (copy of birth certificate, passport, certified baptismal record, driver’s license or U.S. government identification). Contact your Membership Chair for more information.

MULTI’S: The Multi’s Regional Championships will take place on July 13-14, 2019 in Las Vegas, NV (Location TBA). Please contact Stacey Cooper at: president@nevada.usatf or (702) 885-1471. You must register for this event by June 25, 2019. Please go to <http://www.nevada.usatf.org> for more information.

WAIVER: All athletes who participate in the USATF Junior Olympic Program must complete the Junior Olympic Participant Waiver and Release form. This form is already integrated in the online entry system and can be completed electronically, or through your association. All forms must be submitted at the first round of the Junior Olympic series.

AWARDS: USATF Junior Olympic medals will be awarded to the top three (3) individuals and the top three (3) relay teams in each event of each age division.

ADVANCEMENTS: The top **8** individuals and relay teams in each event of each age division will advance to the USATF Region **15** Championships. Athletes who have qualified from their Association Championship must declare for the Region 15 Championship the information is listed above.

The National Junior Olympic Championships will be held from Monday, July 22nd through Sunday, July 28th in Sacramento, CA. The top 5 athletes at the Region **15** Championships will qualify for the National Championships. In combined events, the top 2 athletes will automatically qualify. In addition to the top 2 athletes, anyone that meets the qualifying standard in the combined events will also qualify. The standard for each combined event will be published later. IMPLEMENT WEIGH-IN:

Friday, 3 PM - located at the UNLV track field house. Sat/Sun, 7:15AM - Coronado track shed near concessions.

EVENT CHECK-IN: There will be separate check-in areas for Running and Field events. Athletes for running events must check in at the designated area 30 minutes prior to the event's scheduled starting time. Athletes for field events will check in at the field event 30 minutes prior to the start time for the event.

COMPETITION BIB NUMBERS: All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during competition and on the front on their jerseys only. If an athlete loses the bib number, a replacement can be purchased for a fee of \$5. Bib numbers will be distributed to athletes **at the finish line under the tent.**

EVENT RESULTS: During competition, event results will be posted near the tennis court just outside clerking area. Additionally, event results will be posted online at: <http://www.finishedresults.com>.

PROTESTS: There will be a \$75 fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted to the Protest Referee at once and not later than 30 minutes after a result has been posted. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

RULES OF CONDUCT & FACILITY:

Coaches, please control your athletes and parents. Please inform them of the rules of conduct and what is expected of them. Rules are as follows:

1. 3/16th or smaller pyramid spikes are required.
2. Profane language, aggressive behavior or actions deemed not sportsmanlike or an environment that does not consider the presence of children, is prohibited.
3. Canopies must be secured and are limited to the top portions of the stadium. Large umbrellas may not be used in the mid or lower areas of the stadium as they impede spectator views.
4. No basketballs, footballs, soccer balls, boom boxes or skateboards are allowed in the stadium.
5. Absolutely no dogs or designer dogs, or other animals will be allowed in the stadium. Please don't try to hide them in your purse or jacket. You and your dog will be asked to leave.
6. The 90 day rule is in effect. There are no changes in affiliation or roster additions after the close of entries for the association meet.
7. No alcoholic beverages or smoking is allowed whatsoever on or around school premises. You and your athlete will be asked to leave the facility.
8. Coaches please inform your athletes that they can only take water onto the infield in their track bags.
9. Absolutely no food, sunflower seeds, gum or Gatorade type drinks are allowed on the infield. Please explain that these types of items are damaging to the infield and will cause us to receive a negative report with the Athletics department who has given us permission to utilize their facility. Athletes not complying with this will be disqualified from the meet.
10. Please ensure you and your athletes pick up your trash and disposing them in the proper trash bins.
11. THE CAMPUS IS OFF LIMITS!!!..... Campus police will be very strict about this rule.
12. Anyone wishing to park a Recreation Vehicle (RV) on campus must contact meet management to reserve a spot in the pre-designated area.
